## Mission / Philosophy

The objective of the Capital Projects sector is to enable not-for-profit organizations to complete capital projects that provide significant benefit to communities. Viable capital projects that are primarily for community benefit and are accessible to the public will be considered in three categories:

Facilities: construction, renovation or maintenance of facilities.

Community Infrastructure: public amenities such as docks, parks or playgrounds.

Acquisitions: the purchase of fixed capital assets for long-term use, including vehicles and equipment.

Applicants must have matching funds. Tangible in-kind contributions, such as donated equipment and materials, will be considered as matching funds. Land and intangible in-kind support, such as volunteer time, donated labour or services will not be accepted as matching funds.
